The 27th Annual Region X Safety & Health Summit was held May 10-12, 2022, at the Grove Hotel and The Boise Centre (West) in Boise, Idaho. "Tour de Safety" was the 2022 summit theme.

Classes were held over three days with 188 attendees, 35 exhibitors and 18 sponsors including 3 contactors from CPU River Road Generating Plant. It was supported by: Alaska OSHA, Oregon OSHA, Washington Department of Labor & Industries – DOSH, US Department of Energy (DOE) and the US Department of Labor – OSHA.

Wednesday May 11, 2022, General Session Keynote Speaker:

Brendan McDonough

Topic: Inspiring others to find their tribe of support

Brendon's gripping real life story is conveyed in the motion picture "Only the Brave" based on the true story of the Granite Mountain Hotshots. Brendan is the only survivor of the horrendous Yarnell Hill fire that occurred in 2013. Brendon lost 19 of his dearest co-workers and brothers that day. He provided perspectives on how he had so many obstacles to overcome due to the decisions he made with substance abuse and how those decisions nearly hindered his chances to become a fire fighter. Upon realizing his dream through unconventional means and developing a lasting brotherhood with men he worked alongside of. He lost the men whom he genuinely considered family. He has dealt with the unrelenting guilt of being the only survivor of the tragic fire that occurred on Jun 30, 2013.

One of many take aways from his extraordinary ordeal and message to the Region X audience is, "Purpose: no passion, no purpose, no profession, character defects can be your greatest asset." Brendon continues community service efforts in Arizona in substance abuse support. At the conclusion of his message, he opened the session for questions and answers.

Topic: Failing Safely, building resiliency

Tyson's message to the membership includes Don't define a situation based upon the "absence" of something – safety is the "presence" of something.

Predict the fact that humans will error and give them the ability to fail safely. Anticipate, prevent, catch, recover. To reduce the frequency and severity tailor the work specifically to the process do not depend on the human.

General Session Speaker May 12, 2022: Frank King, The Mental Health Comedian:

Frank King provided a 15-minute overview of the 1-hour session he was scheduled to provide in one of the breakout sessions. He emphasizes and provides tools on the relationship between workplace stress and suicide, and the identification of actions that are common in suicide attempts.
